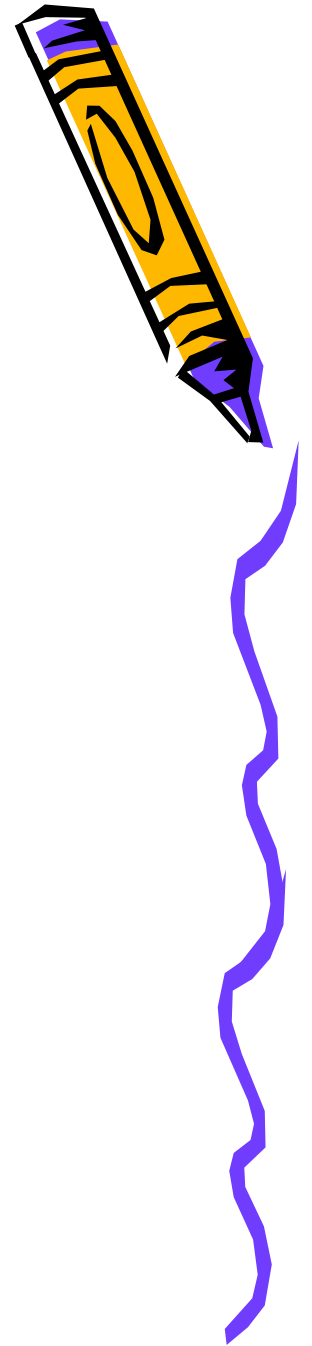
# Research representation

  - Programs that conduct research and evaluation



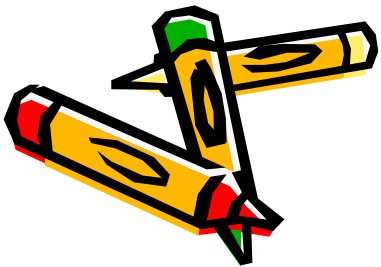
# Representation by diversity

# Where to have future meetings

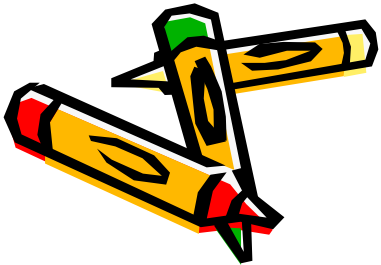
- Center Schools

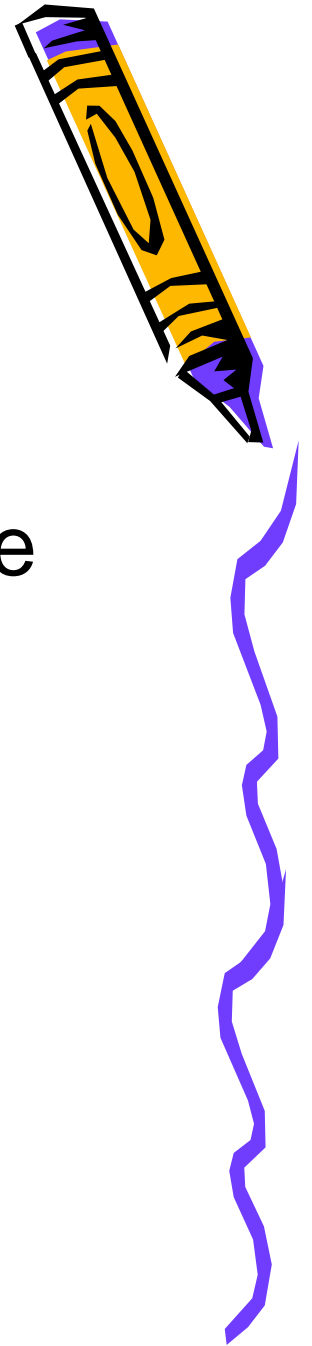
# Process of choosing representatives

- Invite applications from all teacher prep programs
- Request info re demographic characteristics, faculty expertise
- Request statement that they will be committed to assisting in grant development
- Select representatives based on diversity



# Process cont.

- Classify teacher prep programs or individuals by characteristics and use stratified random sampling.
